

105 Schools of Choice Application Guidelines for the 2018-2019 School Year

## Bendle Public Schools

Applications will be accepted June 25, 2018 through 4:00 PM, July 26, 2018.

### ***Enrollment Guidelines***

The Bendle Public School District is accepting applications for enrollment for the 2018-2019 school year for students who do not reside within the district's boundaries pursuant to section 105 of the State Aid Act. There are limited openings in the K-12 grade levels.

Transportation will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian.

Students are not charged tuition and they do not need a release from their resident district if accepted for enrollment in Bendle Public Schools under section 105 Schools of Choice program.

Bendle Public Schools may refuse to enroll a nonresident applicant if any of the following applies:

- The applicant is or has been, within the preceding two years, suspended from another school.
- The applicant has been expelled from another district.
- The applicant has been convicted of a felony.

All Student Code of Conduct rules, procedures and policies will apply to all students who enter Bendle Public Schools under the School of Choice guidelines and procedures.

Applications may be obtained at Bendle Public Schools Administration Building, 3420 Columbine Ave., Burton, or online at [www.bendleschools.org](http://www.bendleschools.org). Applications will be accepted beginning Monday, June 25, 2018, through 4:00 PM, Thursday, July 26, 2018.

Notification will take place on or before Monday, August 13, 2018, after student records are reviewed. If the number of applications exceeds the number of openings, a lottery will be performed and a waiting list will be maintained for the remaining applications. If accepted, the student should be enrolled on or before Tuesday, September 4, 2018 however no later than Friday, September 7, 2018.
